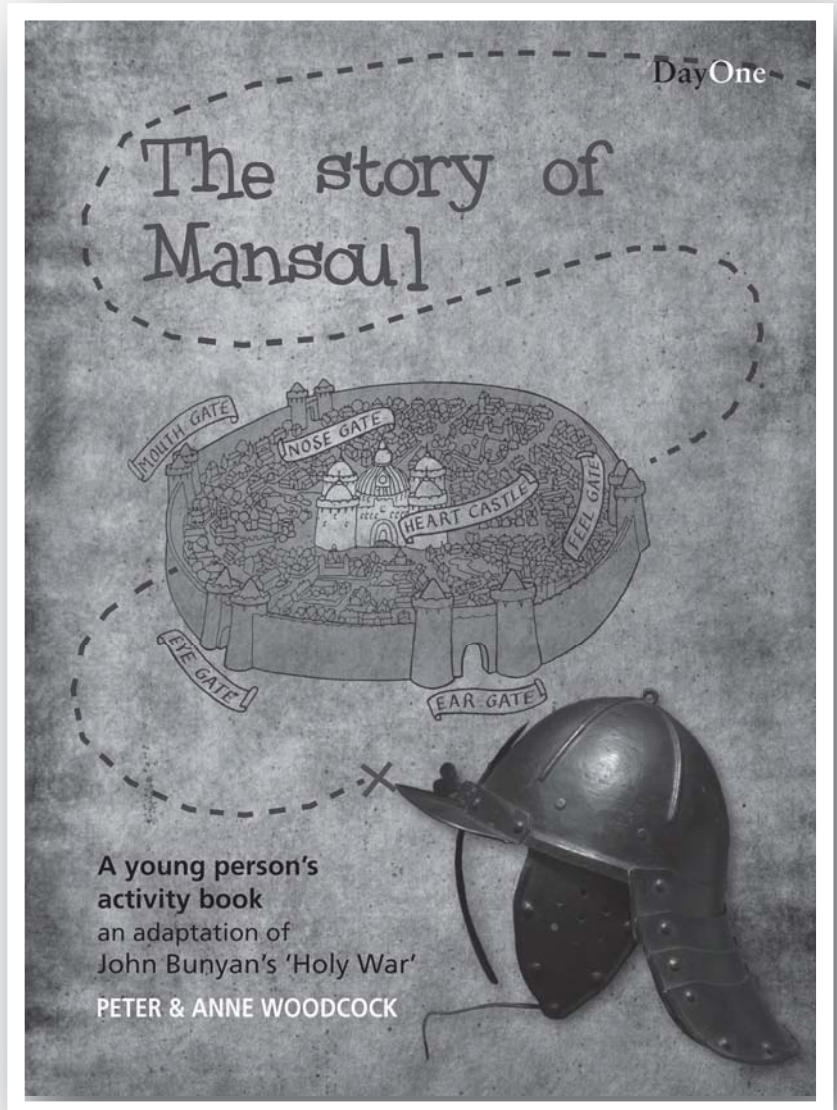

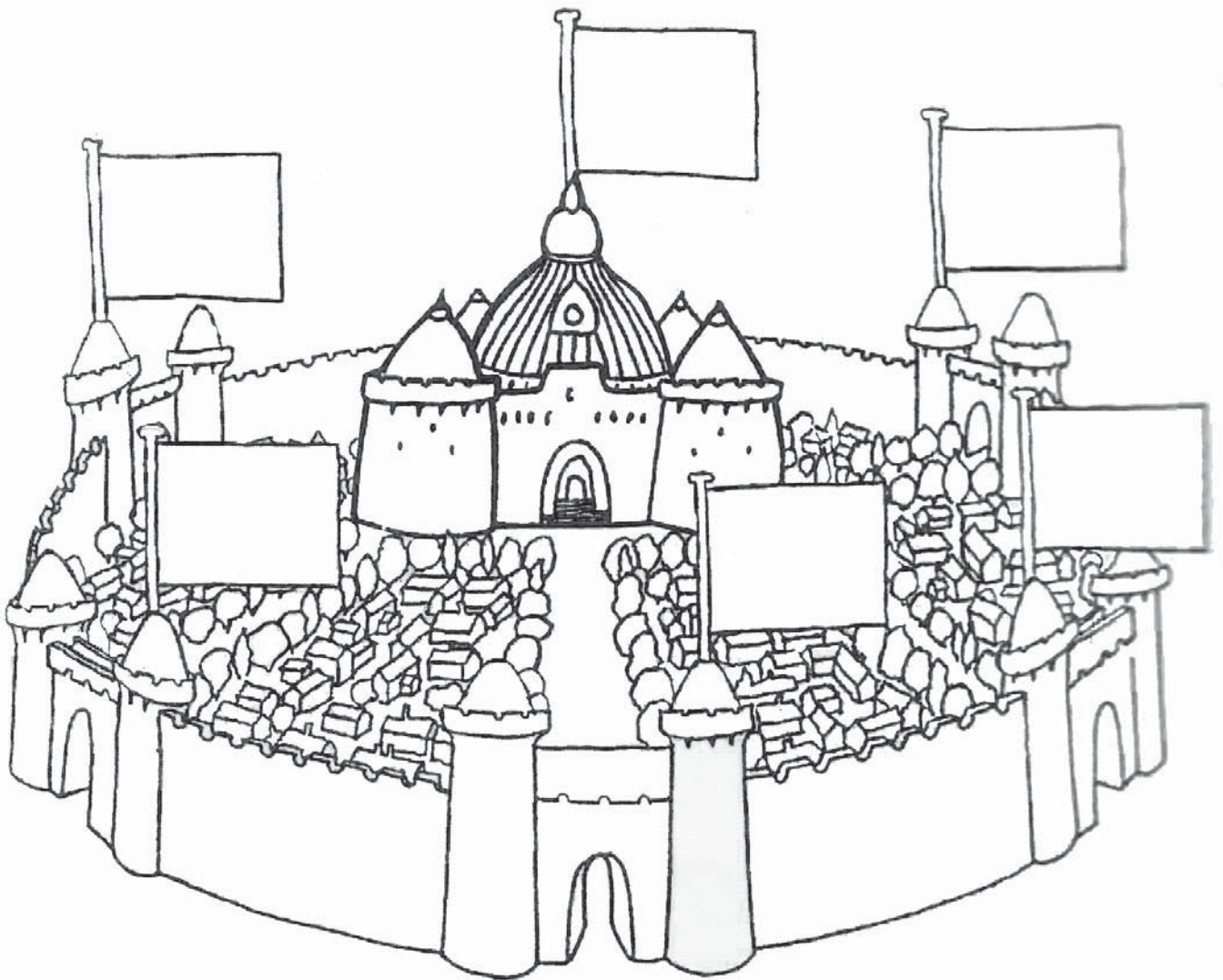

Genesis chapter 1 verses 26 to 31

1. God created (made) man in his own image (verse 27.) This means we are different from everything else God made. How are you different from a plant and an animal?
2. Verses 29 to 30. How do these verses show us that we need God? (Think about what he gives us.)
3. Verse 31. What did God think about the things he had made?

If you want to know more, read chapters 1 and 2 of Genesis. There you will find the whole story of God making the world.
