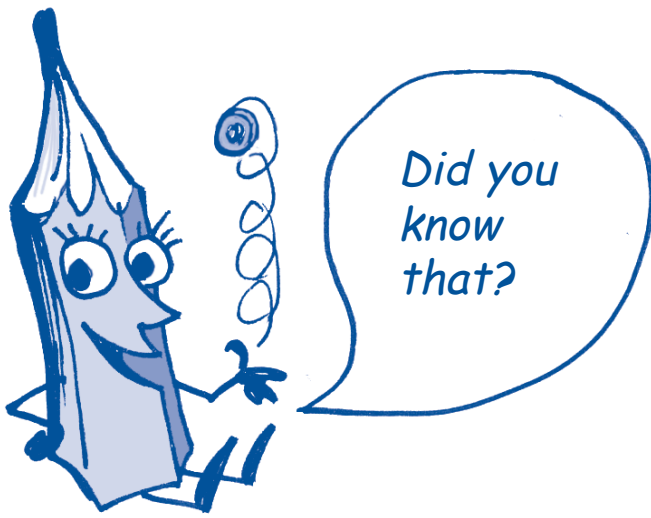

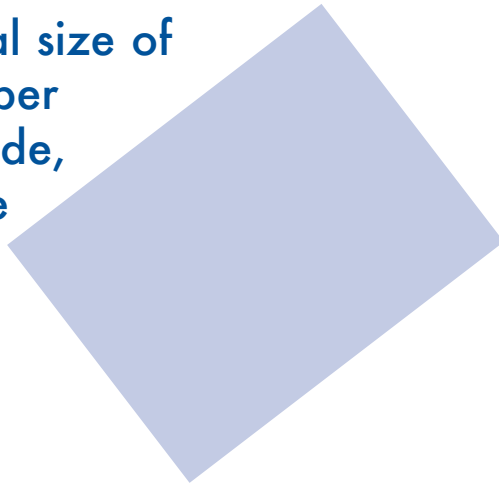

The first paper money was made in China in 960.

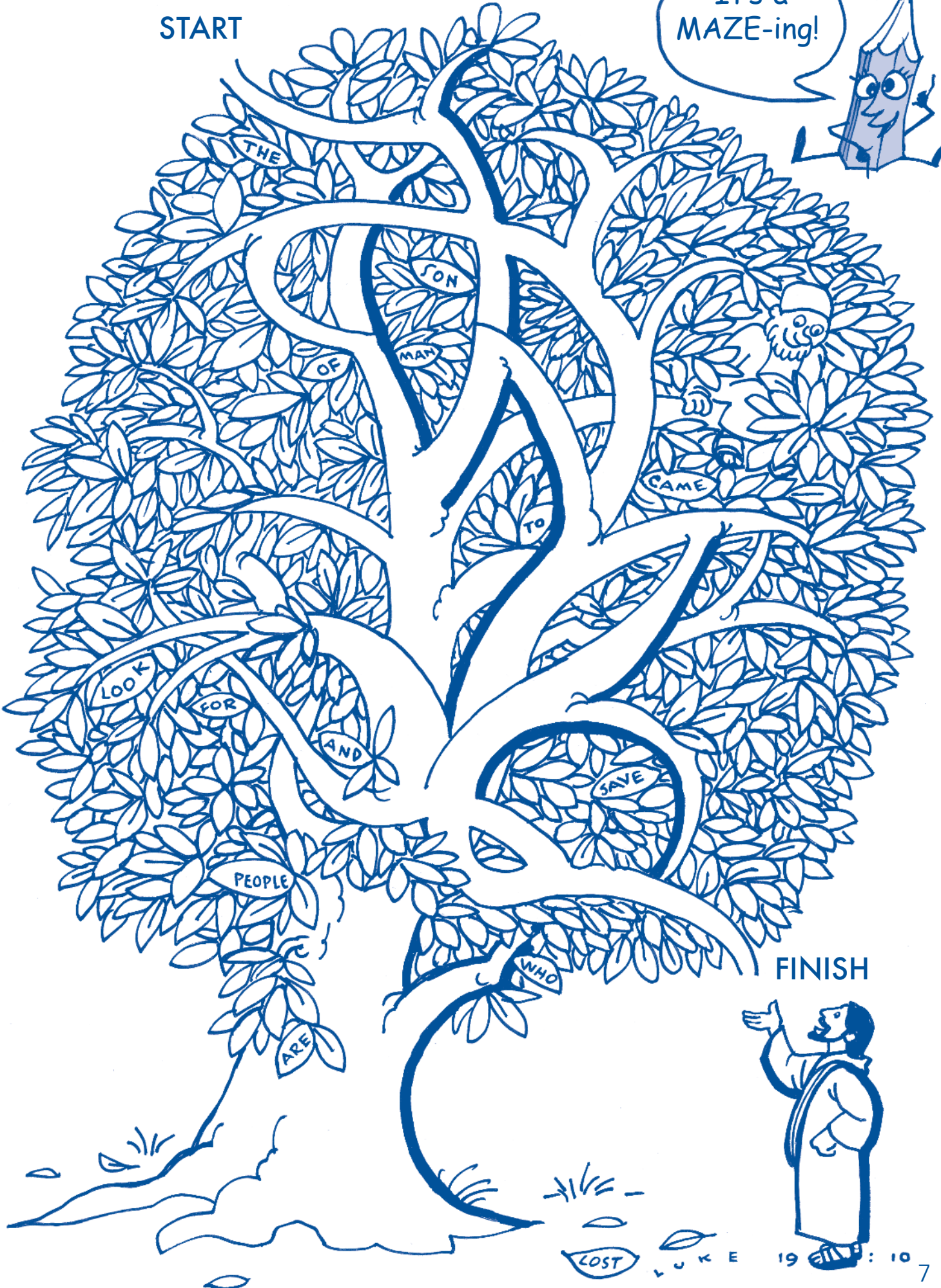


The oldest coin was made in Turkey about 630 BC.
