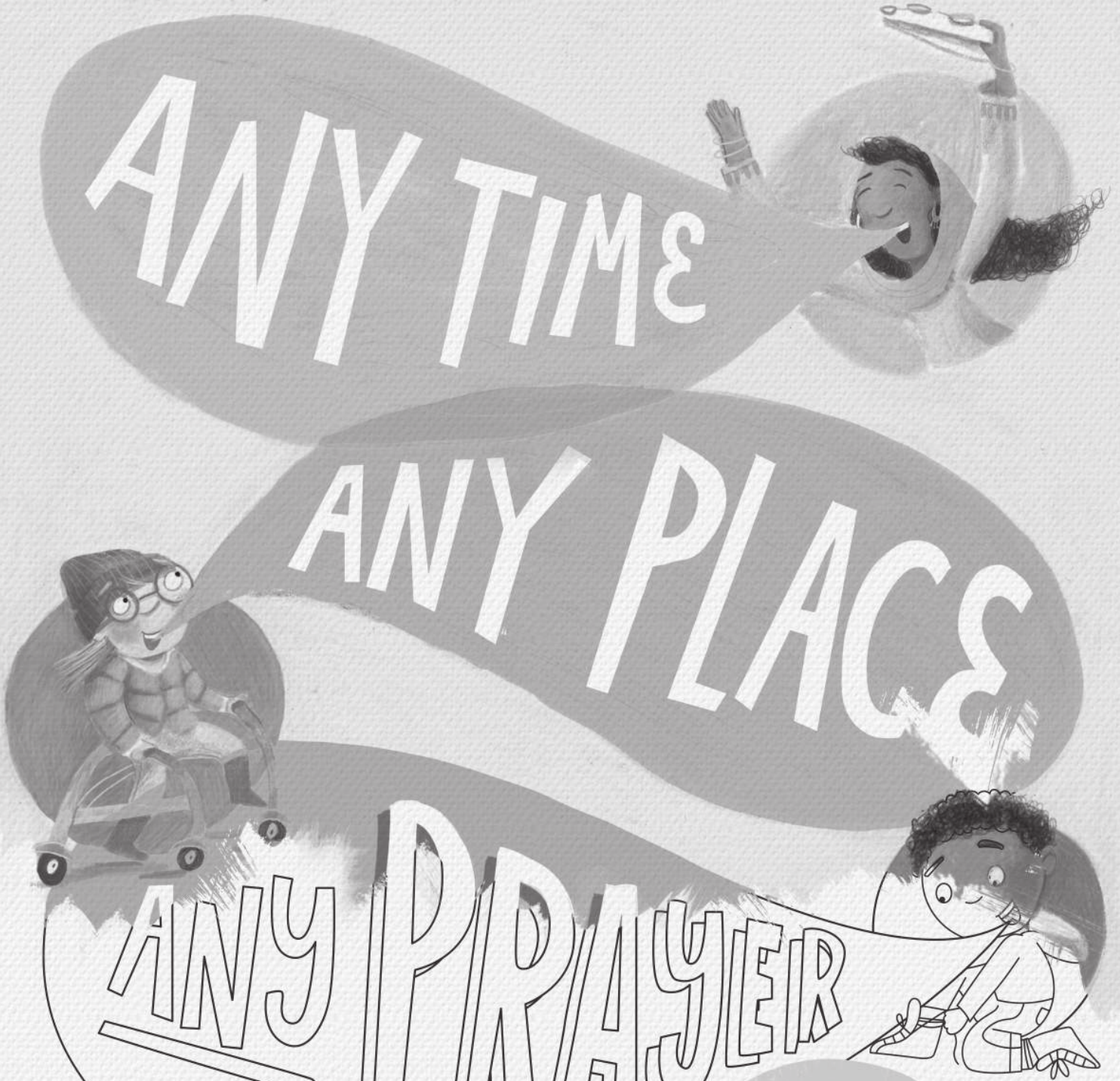

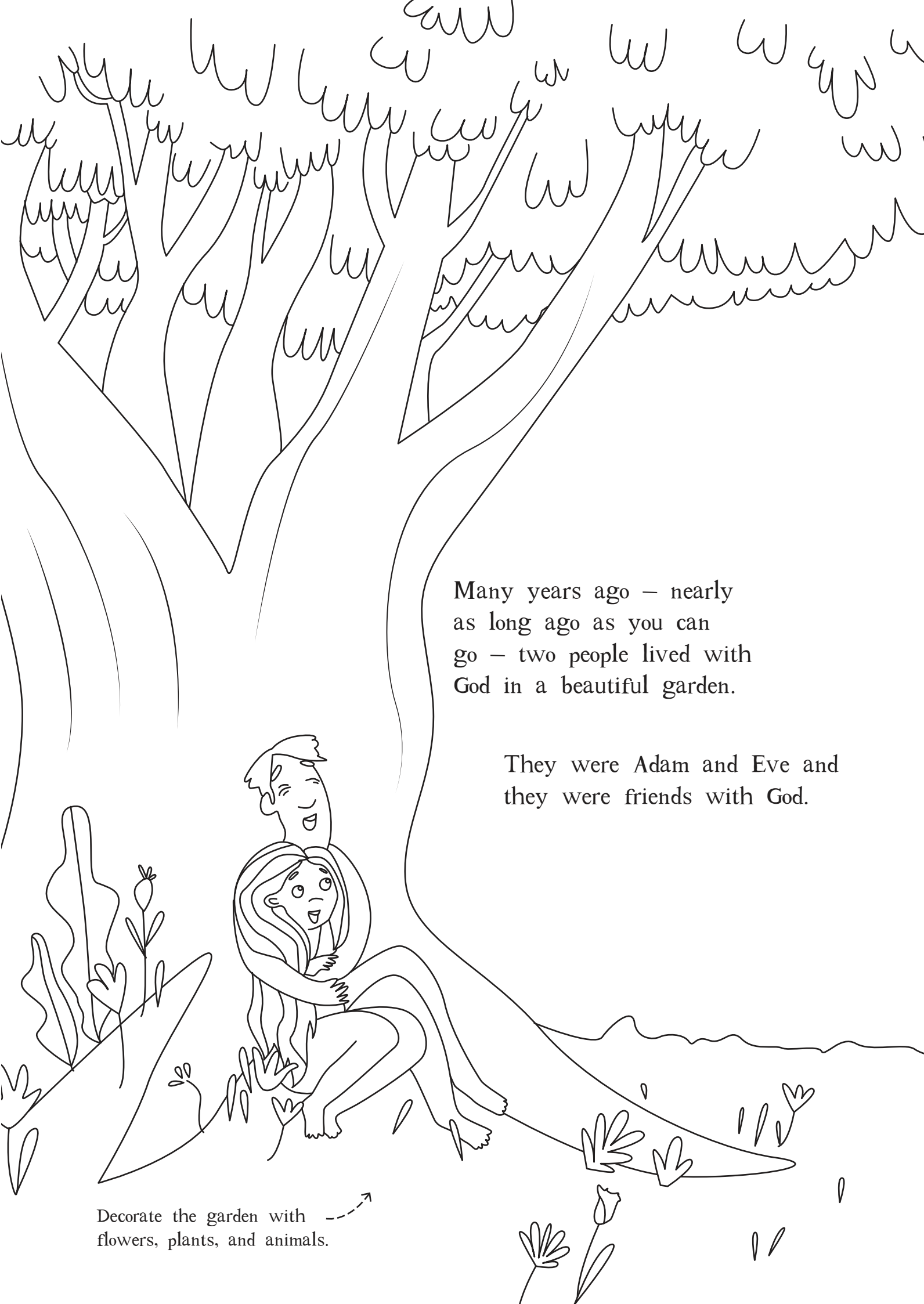

flowers, plants, and animals.

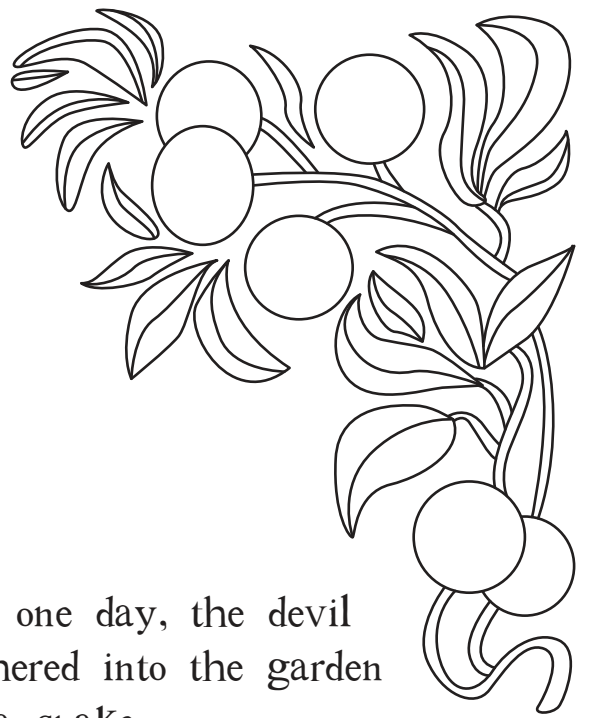
# Spot the difference

Can you spot the five differences in these pictures?

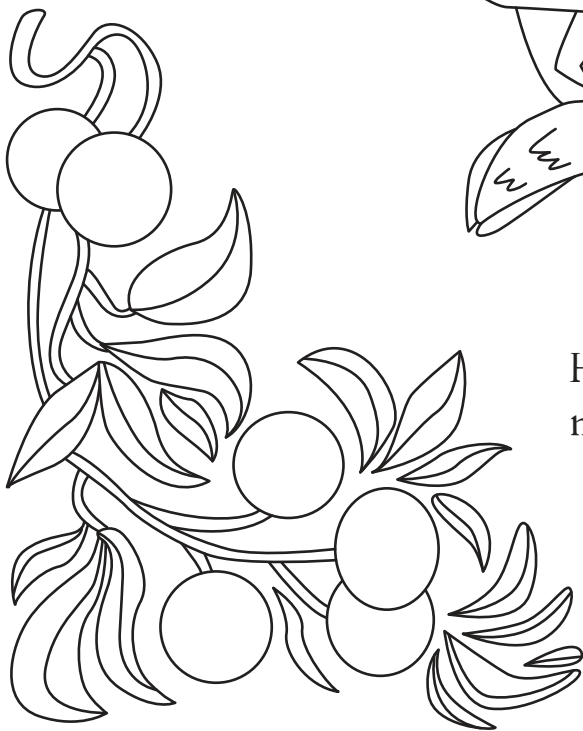
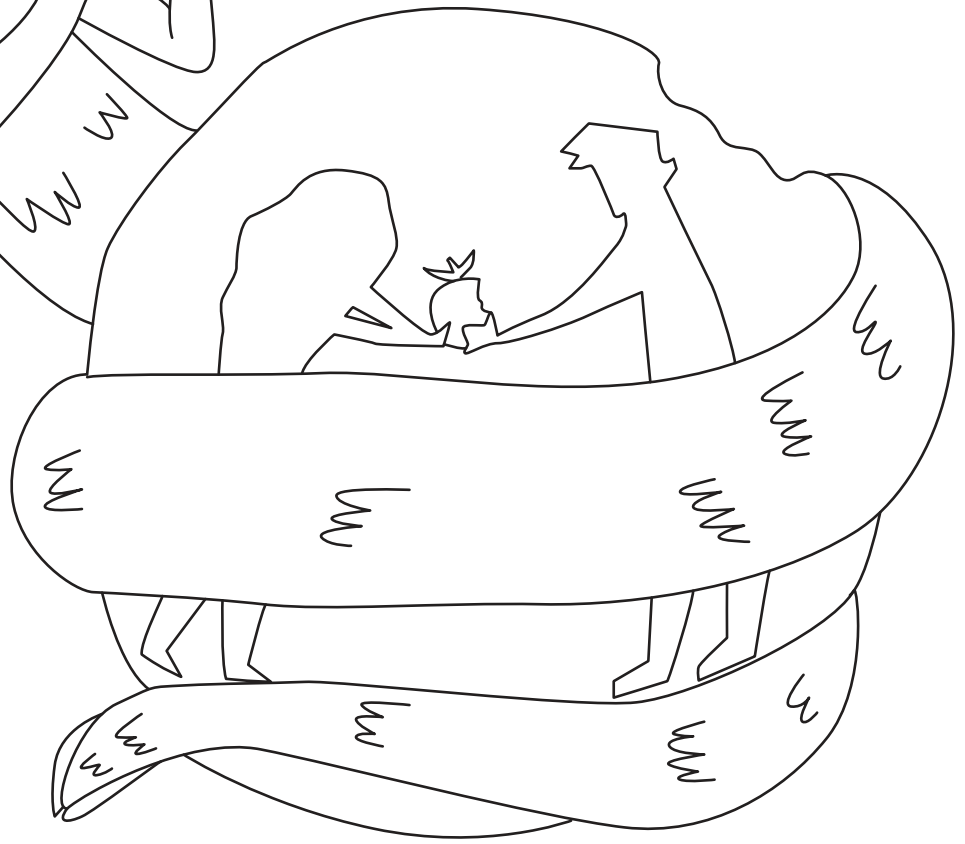


Adam and Eve could talk with God about every thought they had. They told him anything, anytime.

as a snake.

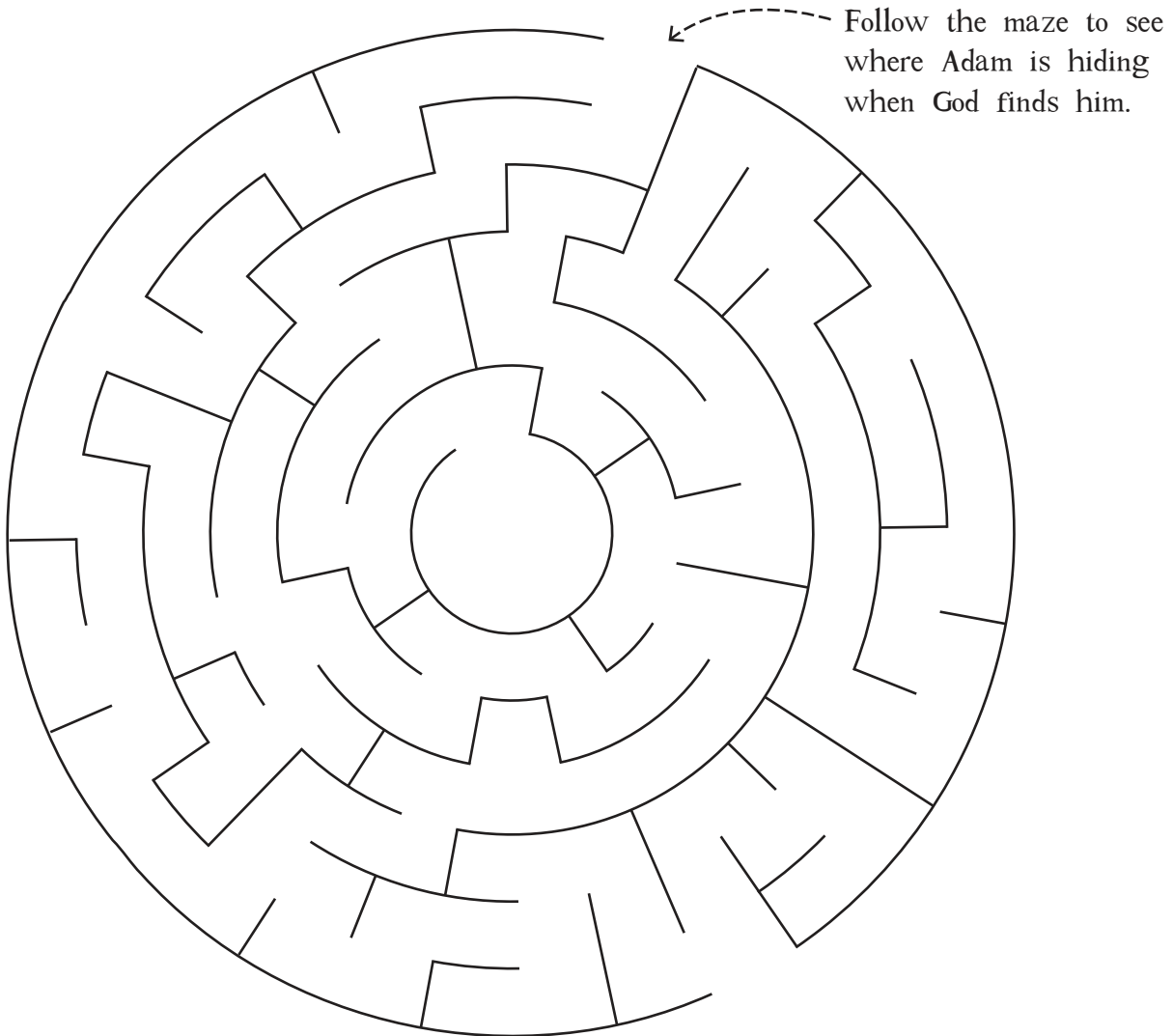



He suggested that God did

so they hid. But God found them.



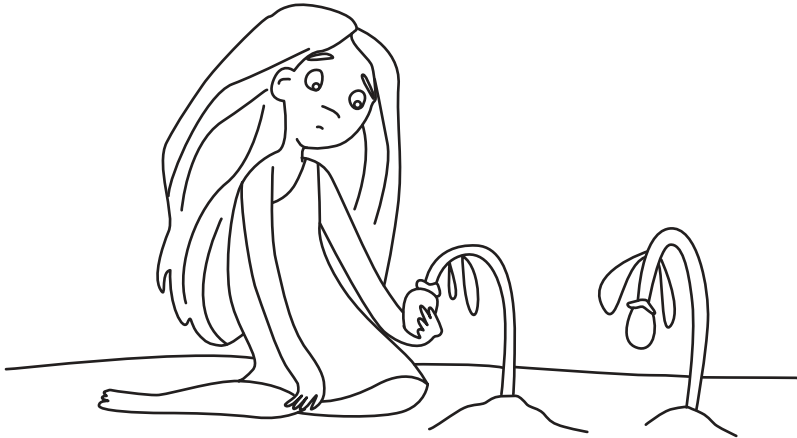


Because of their sin, Adam and Eve would have to live outside God's garden, separated from him.
