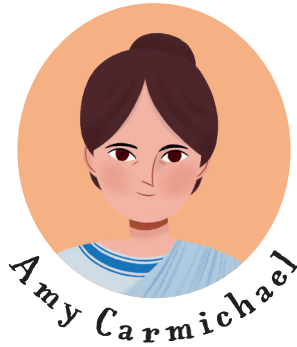


Do Great Things for God
