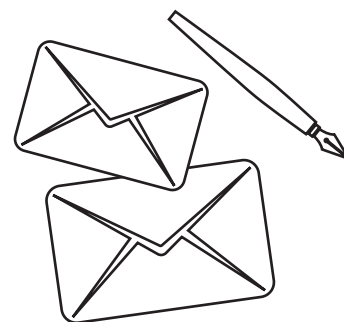

Day 5: Encourage Your Church Leaders

- Are there any ways you could encourage the leaders at your church and their families?

- What are some ways that you can pray for your church and its leaders?
